#### Patio Build Project

- o Committee motion made by Facility to increase the patio project budget by \$4,000 (not to exceed \$12,000) Motion was unanimously approved
- o VFW Membership unanimously voted to approve \$8,000 at the October 2024 meeting
  - o Recommend to VFW a budget of \$7,000 for materials and \$5,000 for labor costs.

### Canteen Bartender Station Project On hold due to vendor (Pepsi) negotiation stall

  - o Additional \$3500 estimated for demo and Pepsi hookups
  - o Funding will come from the Canteen Savings Account Surplus
